This includes clothing, clinic, fresh produce, after school programs, gym, furniture 1 in 7 children in Central Ohio are hungry In 2014; 12,580 families were served In 2023; 243,516 families were served This service has no zip code restrictions Mid Ohio Food Collective is a large supporter, along with Food Recue USA, and partnerships with local groceries They move 58 pallets of fresh produce per week. Thursdays they distribute meat Their goal is to create employment by reducing poverty and keeping youth busy and off the streets.
