Tall Oaks Winterwood Apartments, contempt motion, Fanny Mae has filed for foreclosure, units need major renovations, talking through next steps with the owners. Carriage House & Northtown Apartments, both cases have been closed. These will stay in an injunction to ensure they stay in compliance for their residence. Sarah will be moving careers to be on the new Franklin County team. Her replacement, Louisa, has been working to represent Zone 5, currently going into 2nd year on the Property Action team, will be overseeing code enforcement and hotel objections. Louisa went to Horizon Science Academy and is looking forward to working closer with the homeowners and businesses in Northland. |
